Comal County reports 70 new COVID-19 cases; one death

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE: November 9, 2021:

NEW BRAUNFELS— Comal County reports 70 new COVID-19 cases today, bringing the County total to 19,746. Comal County Public Health also confirms the death of a Canyon Lake woman in her 50's. She passed away on October 14 at a hospital in San Antonio. The total number of deceased is now 456.

On Tuesday, Comal County hospitals reported caring for 10 COVID-19 patients; of those, three are in intensive care and two are on ventilators.

Approximately 100 % of these patients are unvaccinated.

Not all COVID positive patients hospitalized in Comal County are necessarily county residents.

The percentage of fully vaccinated was previously calculated on the number of residents who are 12 years of age and older. However, the percentage now includes residents five years of age and older, which brought down the percentage.

Comal County Public Health Department is administering Moderna COVID-19 vaccines for those 18 and older and Pfizer vaccines for anyone 12 years old and older. Once Public Health receives a standing order from the Public Health Authority for Region 8, our clinic will also have vaccines available for the 5+ age group.

Those who are high risk and qualify for a 3rd dose or a booster can also call to schedule an appointment for a vaccine.
