### Comal County reports 23 new COVID-19 cases; one death

**FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE: November 12, 2021:**

*NEW BRAUNFELS*— Comal County reports 23 new COVID-19 cases today, bringing the County total to 19,798. Public Health also confirms the death of a Canyon Lake man in his 40's. He passed away on November 7 at a New Braunfels hospital. The total number of deceased is now 457.

On Friday, Comal County hospitals reported caring for seven COVID-19 patients; of those, two are in intensive care. There are no patients on ventilators today.

Approximately 65 % of these patients are unvaccinated.

Not all COVID positive patients hospitalized in Comal County are necessarily county residents.

The percentage of fully vaccinated was previously calculated on the number of residents who are 12 years of age and older. However, the percentage now includes residents five years of age and older, which brought down the percentage.

**Comal County Public Health Department is administering Moderna COVID-19 vaccines for those 18 and older and Pfizer vaccines for anyone five years old and older.**

**Those who are high risk and qualify for a 3<sup>rd</sup> dose or a booster can also call to schedule an appointment for a vaccine. Appointments can be made by calling 830.221.1150. Please be patient as call volume is high at this time.**
