Comal County reports 68 new COVID-19 cases; three deaths

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE: November 15, 2021:

NEW BRAUNFELS— Comal County reports 68 new COVID-19 cases today, bringing the County total to 19,866. Public Health also confirms the deaths of three Comal County residents:

- A Canyon Lake man in his 60s on 11/6/2021 at a New Braunfels hospital
- A New Braunfels man in his 80s on 10/24/2021 at home
- A New Braunfels man in his 70s on 11/10/2021 at a New Braunfels hospital

The total number of deceased is now 460.

On Monday, Comal County hospitals reported caring for seven COVID-19 patients; of those, three are in intensive care and two are on ventilators.

Approximately 100% of these patients are unvaccinated.

Not all COVID positive patients hospitalized in Comal County are necessarily county residents.
