Comal County reports 19 new COVID-19 cases; two deaths

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE: November 17, 2021:

NEW BRAUNFELS— Comal County reports 19 new COVID-19 cases today, bringing the County total to 19,953. Public Health also confirms the deaths of two Comal County residents:

- A Spring Branch woman in her 60s on 11/14/2021 at a New Braunfels hospital
- A New Braunfels man in his 80s on 11/11/2021 at a Seguin hospital

The total number of deceased is 462.

On Wednesday, Comal County hospitals reported caring for nine COVID-19 patients; of those, one is in intensive care and is on a ventilator.

Approximately 78% of these patients are unvaccinated.

Not all COVID positive patients hospitalized in Comal County are necessarily county residents.
