### **Comal County reports 25 new COVID-19 cases; one death**

**FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE: November 19, 2021:**

*NEW BRAUNFELS*— Comal County reports 25 new COVID-19 cases today, bringing the County total to 19,996. Public Health also confirms the death of a New Braunfels resident under the age of 18. The child passed away at a San Antonio hospital on 10/20/2021. The total number of deceased is now 464.

On Friday, Comal County hospitals reported caring for 11 COVID-19 patients; of those, two are in intensive care. There are no COVID patients on ventilators today. Approximately 91% of these patients are unvaccinated. Not all COVID positive patients hospitalized in Comal County are necessarily county residents.
