### **Comal County reports 36 new COVID-19 cases; two deaths**

**FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE: November 30, 2021:**

*NEW BRAUNFELS*— Comal County reports 36 new COVID-19 cases today, bringing the County total to 20,213. Public Health also confirms the deaths of two Comal County residents:

- A New Braunfels man in his 70s on 11/16/2021 at a New Braunfels hospital
- A Spring Branch man in his 80s on 11/22/2021 at a San Antonio hospital

The total number of deceased is now 467.

On Tuesday, Comal County hospitals reported caring for 12 COVID-19 patients; of those, three are in intensive care and two are on ventilators.

Approximately 100 % of these patients are unvaccinated.

Not all COVID positive patients hospitalized in Comal County are necessarily county residents.
