Comal County reports 50 new COVID-19 cases; two deaths

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE: December 3, 2021:

NEW BRAUNFELS— Comal County reports 50 new COVID-19 cases today, bringing the County total to 20,345. Public Health also confirms the deaths of two Comal County residents:

- A New Braunfels man in his 80s on 12/1/2021 at a New Braunfels hospital
- A New Braunfels man in his 30s on 11/22/2021 at home

The total number of deceased is now 470.

On Friday, Comal County hospitals reported caring for seven COVID-19 patients; of those, two are in intensive care and two are on ventilators.

Approximately 100 % of these patients are unvaccinated.

Not all COVID positive patients hospitalized in Comal County are necessarily county residents.
