### **Comal County reports 183 new COVID-19 cases; five deaths**

**FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE: December 28, 2021:**

*NEW BRAUNFELS*— Comal County reports 183 new COVID-19 cases today, bringing the County total to 21,022. Public Health also confirms the deaths of five Comal County residents:

- A Canyon Lake woman in her 60s on 12/22/2021 at home
- A Bulverde man in his 70s on 12/18/2021 at a San Antonio Hospital
- A Bulverde man in his 50s on 12/10/2021 at a San Antonio Hospital
- A New Braunfels man in his 70s on 12/10/2021 at home
- A New Braunfels man in his 60s on 12/3/2021 at a New Braunfels Hospital

The total number of deceased is now 482.

Keep in mind, today's numbers reflect data collected over a five-day period, including the holiday weekend.

On Tuesday, Comal County hospitals reported caring for 15 COVID-19 patients; of those, five are in intensive care and four are on ventilators.

Approximately 100% of these patients are unvaccinated.

Not all COVID positive patients hospitalized in Comal County are necessarily county residents.
