Comal County reports 379 new COVID-19 cases; one death

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE: January 12, 2022:

NEW BRAUNFELS— Comal County reports 379 new COVID-19 cases today bringing total cases in the County to 23,343.

Public Health also confirms the death of a New Braunfels man in his 60's. He passed away at a New Braunfels hospital on January 7.

The total number of deceased is now 487.

On Wednesday, Comal County hospitals reported caring for 50 COVID-19 patients; of those, nine are in intensive care and two are on ventilators.

Approximately 84% of these patients are unvaccinated.

Not all COVID positive patients hospitalized in Comal County are necessarily county residents.
