### **Comal County reports 315 new COVID-19 cases; one death**

**FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE: January 13, 2022:**

*NEW BRAUNFELS*— Comal County reports 315 new COVID-19 cases today bringing total cases in the County to 23,658.

Public Health also confirms the death of a New Braunfels man in his 60's. He passed away at a San Antonio hospital on January 4.

The total number of deceased is now 488.

On Thursday, Comal County hospitals reported caring for 52 COVID-19 patients; of those, nine are in intensive care and two are on ventilators.

Approximately 89% of these patients are unvaccinated.

Not all COVID positive patients hospitalized in Comal County are necessarily county residents.
