Comal County reports 305 new COVID-19 cases; two deaths

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE: January 18, 2022:

NEW BRAUNFELS— Comal County reports 305 new COVID-19 cases today bringing total cases in the County to 24,328.

Public Health also confirms the deaths of two Comal County residents:

- A Bulverde woman in her 80s on 12/31/2021 at home
- A New Braunfels man in his 70s on 1/13/2021 at a New Braunfels hospital

The total number of deceased is now 490.

On Tuesday, Comal County hospitals reported caring for 60 COVID-19 patients; of those, 12 are in intensive care and five are on ventilators.

Approximately 66% of these patients are unvaccinated.

Not all COVID positive patients hospitalized in Comal County are necessarily county residents.
