### **Comal County reports 329 new COVID-19 cases; three deaths**

**FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE: January 27, 2022:**

*NEW BRAUNFELS*— Comal County reports 329 new COVID-19 cases today bringing the County's total cases to 26,714.

Public Health also confirms the deaths of three Comal County residents:

- A New Braunfels man in his 70s on 1/19/2022 at a New Braunfels hospital
- A Southern Comal County man in his 80s on 1/8/2022 at home
- A New Braunfels woman in her 80s on 1/14/2022 at home

The total number of deceased is now 494.

On Thursday, Comal County hospitals reported caring for 57 COVID-19 patients; of those, eight are in intensive care and five are on ventilators.

Approximately 82% of these patients are unvaccinated.

Not all COVID positive patients hospitalized in Comal County are necessarily county residents.
