Comal County reports 304 new COVID-19 cases; two deaths

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE: January 28, 2022:

NEW BRAUNFELS — Comal County reports 304 new COVID-19 cases today bringing the County’s total cases to 27,018.

Public Health also confirms the deaths of two Comal County residents:

- A Canyon Lake woman in her 60s on 1/21/2022 at a New Braunfels hospital
- A New Braunfels man in his 80s on 1/22/2022 at home

The total number of deceased is now 496.

On Friday, Comal County hospitals reported caring for 58 COVID-19 patients; of those, eight are in intensive care and four are on ventilators.

Approximately 79% of these patients are unvaccinated.

Not all COVID positive patients hospitalized in Comal County are necessarily county residents.
