### **Comal County reports 317 new COVID-19 cases; five deaths**

**FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE: February 1, 2022:**

*NEW BRAUNFELS*— Comal County reports 317 new COVID-19 cases today bringing the County's total cases to 27,724.

Public Health also confirms the deaths of five Comal County residents:

- Canyon Lake man in his 80s on 1/29/2022 at home
- A New Braunfels woman in her 70s on 1/17/2022 at a San Antonio hospital
- A Canyon Lake woman in her 70s on 1/22/2022 at a New Braunfels hospital
- A New Braunfels woman in her 90s on 1/24/2022 at home
- A Canyon Lake man in his 70s on 1/25/2022 at a San Marcos hospital

The total number of deceased is now 501.

On Tuesday, local hospitals report 60 COVID positive patients are currently hospitalized. Of those, 18 are in intensive care and six are on ventilators.

Approximately 71% of these patients are unvaccinated.

Not all COVID positive patients hospitalized in Comal County are necessarily county residents.
