Comal County reports 146 new COVID-19 cases; two deaths

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE: February 15, 2022:

NEW BRAUNFELS— Comal County reports 146 new COVID-19 cases today bringing the County's total number of cases to 29,625.

Public Health also confirms the deaths of two Comal County residents:

- A New Braunfels man in his 60s on 2/2/2022 at a San Antonio hospital
- A New Braunfels woman in her 60s on 2/11/2022 at a New Braunfels hospital

The total number of deceased is now 518.

On Tuesday, local hospitals report 34 COVID positive patients are currently hospitalized. Of those, nine are in intensive care and five are on ventilators.

Approximately 73% of these patients are unvaccinated.

Not all COVID positive patients hospitalized in Comal County are necessarily county residents.
