Comal County reports 41 new COVID-19 cases

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE: February 22, 2022:

NEW BRAUNFELS — Comal County reports 41 new COVID-19 cases today bringing the County’s total number of cases to 29,815.
The total number of deceased remains 521.

On Tuesday, local hospitals report 16 COVID positive patients are currently hospitalized. Of those, six are in intensive care and two are on ventilators.
Approximately 49% of these patients are unvaccinated.
Not all COVID positive patients hospitalized in Comal County are necessarily county residents.
