Comal County reports 101 new COVID-19 cases; three deaths

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE: February 23, 2022:

NEW BRAUNFELS— Comal County reports 101 new COVID-19 cases today bringing the County's total number of cases to 29,916.

Public Health also confirms the deaths of three Comal County residents:

- A Canyon Lake woman in her 80s on 2/20/2022 at a New Braunfels hospital
- A Canyon Lake man in his 70s on 2/2/2022 at a San Antonio hospital
- A New Braunfels woman in her 40s on 2/13/2022 at a San Antonio hospital

The total number of deceased is now 524.

Today's numbers reflect data collected over the weekend and President's Day holiday.

On Wednesday, local hospitals report 16 COVID positive patients are currently hospitalized. Of those, seven are in intensive care and three are on ventilators.

Approximately 50% of these patients are unvaccinated.

Not all COVID positive patients hospitalized in Comal County are necessarily county residents.
