Comal County reports 61 new COVID-19 cases; two deaths

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE: February 24, 2022:

NEW BRAUNFELS— Comal County reports 61 new COVID-19 cases today bringing the County's total number of cases to 29,977.

Public Health also confirms the deaths of two Comal County residents:

- A Spring Branch woman in her 80s on 8/10/2021 at a San Antonio hospital
- A Spring Branch man in his 80s on 2/4/2022 at a San Antonio hospital

The total number of deceased is now 526.

On Thursday, local hospitals report 15 COVID positive patients are currently hospitalized. Of those, seven are in intensive care and two are on ventilators.

Approximately 65% of these patients are unvaccinated.

Not all COVID positive patients hospitalized in Comal County are necessarily county residents.
