### **Comal County reports 24 new COVID-19 cases; two deaths**

**FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE: February 28, 2022:**

*NEW BRAUNFELS*— Comal County reports 24 new COVID-19 cases today bringing the County's total number of cases to 30,076.

Public Health also confirms the deaths of two Comal County residents:

- A Canyon Lake man in his 70s on 2/10/2022 at a San Antonio hospital
- A New Braunfels woman in her 90s on 2/14/2022 at a New Braunfels hospital

The total number of deceased is now 529.

On Monday, local hospitals report 15 COVID positive patients are currently hospitalized. Of those, seven are in intensive care and one is on a ventilator.

Approximately 54% of these patients are unvaccinated.

Not all COVID positive patients hospitalized in Comal County are necessarily county residents.
