Comal County reports 306 new COVID-19 cases; five deaths

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE: February 8, 2022:

NEW BRAUNFELS— Comal County reports 306 new COVID-19 cases today bringing the County's total cases to 28,683.

Public Health also confirms the deaths of five Comal County residents:

- A New Braunfels woman in her 80s on 2/7/2022 at a New Braunfels hospital
- A Canyon Lake woman in her 80s on 2/6/2022 at a New Braunfels hospital
- A New Braunfels man in his 70s on 2/6/2022 at a New Braunfels hospital
- A Bulverde man in his 40s on 1/21/2022 at a San Antonio hospital
- A New Braunfels woman in her 80s on 1/21/2022 at a New Braunfels hospital

The total number of deceased is now 509.

On Tuesday, local hospitals report 36 COVID positive patients are currently hospitalized. Of those, eight are in intensive care and three are on ventilators.

Approximately 82% of these patients are unvaccinated.

Not all COVID positive patients hospitalized in Comal County are necessarily county residents.
