### **Comal County reports five new COVID-19 cases; one death**

**FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE: March 10, 2022:**

*NEW BRAUNFELS*— Comal County reports five new COVID-19 cases today bringing the County's total number of cases to 30,359.

Public Health also confirms the death of a Bulverde man in his 80's. He passed away at home on February 25. The total number of deceased is now 538.

On Thursday, local hospitals report six COVID positive patients are currently hospitalized. Of those, four are in intensive care. There are no COVID patients on ventilators today.

75% of the hospitalized COVID positive patients are unvaccinated.

Not all COVID positive patients hospitalized in Comal County are necessarily county residents.
