### **Comal County reports 46 new COVID-19 cases; two deaths**

**FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE: March 11, 2022:**

*NEW BRAUNFELS*— Comal County reports 46 new COVID-19 cases today bringing the County's total number of cases to 30,405.

Public Health also confirms the deaths of two Comal County residents:

- A North Comal County man in his 60s on 3/7/2022 at a New Braunfels hospital
- A Spring Branch woman in her 60 on 2/9/2022 at a San Antonio hospital

The total number of deceased is now 540.

On Friday, local hospitals report four COVID positive patients are currently hospitalized. Of those, two are in intensive care and one is on a ventilator.

67% of the hospitalized COVID positive patients are unvaccinated.

Not all COVID positive patients hospitalized in Comal County are necessarily county residents.
