Comal County reports 54 new COVID-19 cases; two deaths

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE: March 17, 2022:

NEW BRAUNFELS— Comal County reports 54 new COVID-19 cases today bringing the County's total number of cases to 30,521.

Public Health also reports the deaths of two Comal County residents:

- A Canyon Lake man in his 60s on 2/25/2022 at a San Antonio hospital
- A New Braunfels man in his 70s on 3/9/2022 at home

The total number of deceased is now 542.

On Thursday, local hospitals report three COVID positive patients are currently hospitalized. There are no COVID patients in ICU or on ventilators today.

Approximately 100% of the hospitalized COVID positive patients are unvaccinated.

Not all COVID positive patients hospitalized in Comal County are necessarily county residents.
