Comal County reports four new COVID-19 cases

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE: March 7, 2022:

NEW BRAUNFELS — Comal County reports four new COVID-19 cases today bringing the County’s total number of cases to 30,260.

The total number of deceased remains 532.

On Monday, local hospitals report 11 COVID positive patients are currently hospitalized. Of those, four are in intensive care and two are on ventilators.

Approximately 53% of these patients are unvaccinated.

Not all COVID positive patients hospitalized in Comal County are necessarily county residents.
