Comal County reports 58 new COVID-19 cases; five deaths

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE: March 8, 2022:

NEW BRAUNFELS— Comal County reports 58 new COVID-19 cases today bringing the County's total number of cases to 30,318.

Public Health also confirms the deaths of five Comal County residents:

- A New Braunfels woman in her 70s on 2/26/2022 at a New Braunfels hospital
- A New Braunfels man in his 80s on 2/11/2022 at home
- A Spring Branch woman in her 90s on 2/1/2022 at home
- A New Braunfels man in his 60s on 2/15/2022 at a New Braunfels hospital
- A Canyon Lake woman in her 80s on 2/11/2022 at a San Antonio hospital

The total number of deceased is now 537.

On Tuesday, local hospitals report 13 COVID positive patients are currently hospitalized. Of those, six are in intensive care and two are on ventilators.

Approximately 68% of these patients are unvaccinated.

Not all COVID positive patients hospitalized in Comal County are necessarily county residents.
