Comal County COVID-19 update July 1 – July 7, 2022

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE: July 8, 2022:

NEW BRAUNFELS — Comal County reports 355 new COVID-19 cases for the seven days between July 1 – July 7, 2022.

The total number of cases reported in the County is now 32,877.

Nine COVID-positive patients were hospitalized in Comal County over the seven-day data collection period.

Four new deaths were reported to the Public Health Department this week.

The total number of deceased is now 559.
