Comal County COVID-19 update June 24 – June 30, 2022

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE: June 30, 2022:

NEW BRAUNFELS — Comal County reports 391 new COVID-19 cases for the seven days between June 24 – June 30, 2022.

The total number of cases reported in the County is now 32,522.

An average of six COVID-positive patients were hospitalized in Comal County over the seven-day data collection period.

One new death was reported to the Public Health Department this week.

The total number of deceased is now 555.
