Comal County COVID-19 update September 30 – October 6, 2022

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE: October 7, 2022:

NEW BRAUNFELS — Comal County reports 82 new COVID-19 cases for the seven days between September 30 – October 6, 2022.

The total number of cases reported in the County is now 36,064.

Five COVID-positive patients were hospitalized in Comal County over the seven-day data collection period.

No new deaths were reported to the Public Health Department this week.

The total number of deceased remains 565.

Comal County will discontinue the local daily dashboard and COVID-19 weekly press releases beginning October 14, 2022.

Case numbers in Comal County have steadily declined week after week. Now, with the number of home tests being used and those results not being reported, providing accurate data to our residents has become impassable for the Public Health Department.

Should there be a spike in cases, Comal County will reintroduce the dashboard and press releases as needed to keep the community informed.
