### **Comal County Prepares for possible flooding.**

**FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE, May 11, 2023**

*NEW BRAUNFELS* — The National Weather Service has issued a Flood Watch for Comal County in anticipation of storms expected Friday, May 12, and Saturday, May 13. The Comal County Road Department is prepared to clear roadways of debris and respond to any flooding in our area.

We encourage all residents to be weather aware this weekend and prepare to take necessary safety precautions.

It is important to note, there have been reliability issues with the eight sirens that run along the length of the Guadalupe River to the city limits.

Comal County recently took over maintenance of these sirens as we are working diligently to address all software and equipment failure issues.

*Out of an abundance of caution, we ask the public not to rely upon warning sirens during this weekend's weather events.*

You will find information on any closures of county roads, local rainfall totals, real-time river flow, and lake levels.
