Public Input Needed For County Hazard Mitigation Plan

NEW BRAUNFELS — Comal County residents are invited to provide their feedback as Comal County begins work on a Hazard Mitigation Action Plan (HMAP). The plan, which is required by the Federal Emergency Management Agency, will focus on reducing the risk to life and property posed by naturally occurring events such as storms and floods.

"As part of this process, the public will have several opportunities to provide their input on the natural hazards they face and the best ways to potentially mitigate them," said Jeff Kelley, Comal County emergency management coordinator.
