Proclamation

Recognizing C. Herb Skoog, Recipient of the Frederick Frueholz Jr. Historic Preservation Award

WHEREAS, the Comal County Historical Commission has designated the Frederick Frueholz Jr. Historic Preservation Award in honor of the late Dr. Frederick Frueholz Jr., a longtime member of the Comal County Historical Commission and its first chairman; and

WHEREAS, one recipient is chosen annually by Comal County Historical Commission members based on his or her dedication to the historical preservation of Comal County, and the award is presented each May to celebrate Texas Historic Preservation Month; and

WHEREAS, C. Herb Skoog is the originator of "Reflections," an oral history interview series featuring people of all ages and walks of life from New Braunfels and Comal County; and

WHEREAS, since the program began in 1976, Herb has conducted most of the more than 2,050 interviews aired Sunday mornings on KGNB-AM, producing an invaluable source for researchers of the history of New Braunfels and Comal County; and

WHEREAS, Herb was chairman of the New Braunfels Sesquicentennial Commission in 1995, broadcasting a daily radio program called "New Braunfels Sesquicentennial Minutes" and eventually publishing a book of the same name that has also proved invaluable for historical research; and

WHEREAS, Herb has served in numerous ways to promote the history of the area, including as a radio personality for KGNB-AM and KNBT-FM and as a supporter of Wurstfest.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED that the Comal County Commissioners Court, duly convened and acting in its capacity as the governing body of Comal County, and the Comal County Historical Commission wish to commend C. Herb Skoog on his work toward receiving this award and his dedication to historical preservation and recording the history of Comal County.
