Recognizing October 2019 as Mediation Awareness Month in Comal County

WHEREAS, Hays County Dispute Resolution Center was conceived in 2009 and renamed the Central Texas Dispute Resolution Center in 2015; and


WHEREAS, the Central Texas Dispute Resolution Center serves Comal, Caldwell, Guadalupe and Hays counties in the areas of community, civil, family, divorce and child custody disputes, and offers services to more than half a million people in its service and ancillary areas; and



WHEREAS, about 150 cases are mediated annually, and each court case settled by the Central Texas Dispute Resolution Center saves a county \$5,000 per day in court time; and



WHEREAS, the Central Texas Dispute Resolution Center hosts minimum continuing legal education for attorneys and mediators alike in surrounding counties and conducts peer mediation training that teaches local students lifelong conflict resolution skills.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED that the Comal County Commissioners Court, duly convened and acting in its capacity as the governing body of Comal County, hereby designates October 2019 as Mediation Awareness Month in Comal County, and commends the Central Texas Dispute Resolution Center for its service to Comal County and Central Texas.
