Proclamation

Recognizing May 30, 2019, as World MS Day in Comal County

WHEREAS, multiple sclerosis is an unpredictable, often disabling disease of the central nervous system that interrupts the flow of information within the brain and between brain and body; and

WHEREAS, every year since 2009, the global MS movement comes together on May 30 to provide the public information about MS and to raise awareness on how it affects the lives of more than 2.3 million people around the world – including nearly 1 million in the U.S., according to a recent study, which is twice as many as previously thought; and


WHEREAS, since its inception, World MS Day has grown from strength to strength, reaching hundreds of thousands of people in more than 78 countries worldwide and continuing to grow every year; and

WHEREAS, in the United States, the National Multiple Sclerosis Society is focused on helping people affected by MS live their best lives as it moves toward stopping MS in its tracks, restoring what has been lost and ending MS forever; and

WHEREAS, the 2019 campaign is called “My Invisible MS” with a theme of visibility.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED that the Comal County Commissioners Court, duly convened and acting in its capacity as the governing body of Comal County, proclaims May 30, 2019, as World MS Day, and joins with cities, counties, states and nations around the world in supporting the fight against multiple sclerosis.


