## Honoring the 100th Anniversary of the League of Women Voters

**WHEREAS**, the League of Women Voters was founded in 1920 by the foremothers of the suffragist movement to help the 20 million women who were granted the right to vote by the 19th Amendment understand and carry out their new responsibility as voters; and

**WHEREAS**, with the success of this effort and the tireless efforts over the past 100 years to strengthen and uphold its mission to empower voters and defend democracy, the League has become a trusted nonpartisan, grassroots organization; and

**WHEREAS**, the League has consistently been commended for its nonpartisan election information, including sponsorship of candidate forums and information on state and local ballot issues, as well as its commitment to register, educate and mobilize voters; and


**WHEREAS**, the League of Women Voters believes that active and engaged citizens – regardless of gender, ethnicity or political affiliation – are the hallmark of democracy; and

**WHEREAS**, the League of Women Voters of the Comal Area was founded in 1993 to empower voters and defend democracy in Comal and Guadalupe counties, and since then has assisted local school districts and the Comal County Elections Office in registering voters and providing them with nonpartisan elections information; and

**WHEREAS**, an educated electorate being vital for democracy, Comal County is grateful for the League of Women Voters of the Comal Area's commitment to increasing the knowledge and engagement of local voters.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED** that the Comal County Commissioners Court, duly convened and acting in its capacity as the governing body of Comal County, hereby honors the League of Women Voters on the occasion of its 100th anniversary, and thanks the League of Women Voters of the Comal Area for its dedication to the democratic process in Comal County.
