Proclamation

Recognizing Myra Lee Adams Goff, recipient of the Frederick Frueholz, Jr. Historic Preservation Award

WHEREAS, the Comal County Historical Commission has designated the Frederick Frueholz Jr. Historic Preservation Award in honor of the late Dr. Frederick Frueholz Jr., the first chairman of the Comal County Historical Commission and long-time member; and

WHEREAS, one recipient will be chosen annually by Comal County Historical Commission members and the award presented in May of each year to celebrate Texas Historic Preservation Month; and

WHEREAS, the recipient shall be chosen based on their dedication to the historical preservation of Comal County; and

WHEREAS, fifth-generation New Braunfelser, long-time New Braunfels teacher, and historian laureate, Myra Lee Adams Goff wrote *It's Fair Time*, capturing the history of the Comal County Fair and co-authored three books about New Braunfels history, including *Kindermaskenball, Past and Present; New Braunfels; Comal County - A Pictorial History; and A Journey in Faith, the History of First Protestant Church*. All publications are masterpieces of Comal County and New Braunfels history. For eleven years, Myra Lee wrote the column, "Around the Museum and Archives", about new Braunfels and Comal County history for the New Braunfels Herald-Zeitung. In 2017, a compilation of her articles was published as *Around the Sophienburg*. She was a member of the Comal County Historical Commission from January 2013-December 2020 during which time she researched and wrote numerous narratives for historical markers. Myra Lee was named a New Braunfels Living Legend in 2013, received the 2012 Distinguished Alumni Award from the New Braunfels Independent School District Education Foundation, was named the Sophienburg Museum and Archives Volunteer of the Year in 2006, and received the 2006 Silver Unicorn Award from the New Braunfels Independent School District.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Comal County Commissioners Court duly convened and acting in its capacity as the governing body of Comal County, and the Comal County Historical Commission wish to commend you on your work towards receiving this award and your dedication to historical preservation and recording the history of Comal County and New Braunfels.
