Proclamation

Proclamation recognizing the Community Resource and Recreation Center (CRRC) for forty years of service to Canyon Lake, Comal County, Texas

WHEREAS, the Community Resource & Recreation Center of Canyon Lake, Inc, also known as CRRC, was formally incorporated with the State of Texas on December 23, 2002, and originally founded by six volunteers in February of 1981 when they began searching to find transportation for individuals needing medical care; and
WHEREAS, these six volunteers grew into a team of volunteers who decided there was more they could do for the community; and
WHEREAS, by 1983, the Canyon Lake Volunteer Action Center, as it was then named, opened a clothing closet and food pantry for those in need; and
WHEREAS, with assistance and support from the Canyon Lake Community, the Canyon Lake Action Center purchased four lots to expand services and open a thrift store; and
WHEREAS, In 2003, Canyon Lake Action Center merged with the Recreation Center and became known as the Community Resource and Recreation Center (CRRC); and
WHEREAS, 964 families were served in 2004 steadily increasing to 3,431 families in 2020;
WHEREAS, for 40 years CRRC has served the community with an emergency food pantry, rental and utility assistance, loan of durable medical equipment, and a Thrift Store to keep families in their homes, fed and warm; and
WHEREAS, the COVID-19 pandemic created more families in need, and an increased number at risk of losing their homes, the CRRC enabled more than 139 families to keep their housing during this health crisis; and
WHEREAS, the current CRRC staff, board and volunteers have been planning for the future growth of Canyon Lake and the increased number of residents that will need their services and have constructed a new facility to serve those needs; and
WHEREAS, CRRC staff, board, donors and volunteers are looking forward to the next 40 years in Canyon Lake and are working with other agencies and organizations to expand services; and
WHEREAS, since the initial roots of CRRC, it has been the hearts of caring volunteers that have continued to grow its reach, concerns and abilities, and today – through a precarious and critical era – have never ceased to offer their time and talents, looking not for themselves but for the good of others; and
WHEREAS, CRRC continues to do its tireless work through the strong support of the Canyon Lake Community.
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED that Comal County Commissioners Court does hereby proclaim and recognize February 2021, as the fortieth anniversary of the Community Resource and Recreation Center.
