Proclamation

Recognizing November 2022 as Hospice and Palliative Care Month in Comal County

WHEREAS, hospice and palliative care programs provide pain management, symptom control, psychosocial support and spiritual care to patients and their families when a cure is not possible, meeting people where they are, combining the highest level of quality medical care with the emotional and spiritual support that families need during life’s most difficult journey; and

WHEREAS, hospice provides compassionate care that enables patients and families to focus on living to the fullest despite a life-limiting illness, and bringing peace to individuals in the final months of life; and

WHEREAS, professional and compassionate hospice and palliative care staff and trained volunteers-including physicians, nurses, social workers, therapists, counselors, health aides, and clergy – provide comprehensive care making the wishes of each patient a priority; and

WHEREAS, providing high-quality hospice care reaffirms our belief in the essential dignity of each person, regardless of age, health, or social status, and that every stage of human life deserves to be treated with the utmost respect and dignified care.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED that the Comal County Commissioners Court, duly convened and acting in its capacity as the governing body of Comal County, hereby proclaims the month of November 2022 as Hospice and Palliative Care Month in Comal County and encourages the support and participation of all citizens in learning more about the home care and hospice philosophy of care for the elderly, disabled and the terminally ill.
