**WHEREAS**, the citizens of Comal County play a vital role in assisting all police agencies in Comal County through joint crime, drug, and violence prevention efforts; and


**WHEREAS**, police-community partnerships, neighborhood safety, awareness, and cooperation are important themes of the “National Night Out” program; and

**WHEREAS**, all police agencies in Comal County have continued their commitment to excellence in service and to working together with our communities to keep them safe.




