# Proclamation

## Recognizing September 2022 as “Hunger Action Month” in Comal County

**WHEREAS**, hunger and poverty are issues of vital concern in Texas where 1 in 7 Texans (over 4 million) struggle with hunger; and

**WHEREAS**, the food banks in Comal County and their partners are committed to taking steps to combat hunger in their communities as well as provide resources for those they serve; and

**WHEREAS**, the San Antonio Food Bank, the New Braunfels Food Bank, and Comal County food banks are partners committed to Fighting Hunger and Feeding Hope in conjunction with Feeding America; highlighting the role of food banks in addressing hunger and raising awareness of the need to devote more resources to hunger issues to help vulnerable food insecure populations like kids and seniors; and

**WHEREAS**, food banks in Comal County and their partners serve 4,000 households a month in New Braunfels alone, and the San Antonio Food Bank currently assist around 102,000 households a week throughout 29 counties in the Southwest Texas area; and

**WHEREAS**, the month of September has been designated “Hunger Action Month” in order to bring attention to food insecurity in our communities and to engage the public in action – including volunteer shifts, social media shares, and donations – to end hunger one helping at a time.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED** that the Commissioners Court of Comal County, Texas, duly convened and acting in its capacity as the governing body of Comal County, hereby names September 2022 as Hunger Action Month in Comal County.
