Proclamation

Recognizing Rosemarie Leissner Gregory, Recipient of the Frederick Frueholz, Jr. Historic Preservation Award

WHEREAS, the Comal County Historical Commission has designated the Frederick Frueholz Jr. Historic Preservation Award in honor of the late Dr. Frederick Frueholz Jr., the first chairman of the Comal County Historical Commission and long-time member; and

WHEREAS, one recipient will be chosen annually by Comal County Historical Commission members and the award presented in May of each year to celebrate Texas Historic Preservation Month; and

WHEREAS, the recipient shall be chosen based on their dedication to the historical preservation of Comal County; and

WHEREAS, native New Braunfelser Rosemarie Leissner Gregory co-authored the book *New Braunfels' Historic Landa Park; Its Springs and Its People*, which beautifully details Landa Park through photos and highlights of significant historical and social events and she co-authored *Kindermaskenball, Past and Present; New Braunfels, Comal County - A Pictorial History; and A Journey in Faith, the History of First Protestant Church; and*


WHEREAS, Rosemarie was an active member of the Comal County Historical Commission for over fifteen years and wrote articles for the New Braunfels Herald-Zeitung column "Looking Back"; she is a Blue Coat member of the Greater New Braunfels Chamber of Commerce, a member of the New Braunfels Garden Club, the Friends for the Preservation of Historic Landa Park, and a charter docent for the Museum of Texas Handmade Furniture; and Rosemarie was recently honored by the New Braunfels Parks Foundation and Friends for the Preservation of Historic Landa Park when a bench was placed in her honor at the Landa Family Memorial Butterfly Garden in Landa Park.
