Proclamation

Recognizing May 1-5, 2023 as Jury Appreciation Week in Comal County

WHEREAS, the right to a trial by jury is one of the core values of American Citizenship; and

WHEREAS, the obligation and privilege to serve as a juror are as fundamental to our democracy as the right to vote; and

WHEREAS, our courts depend upon citizens to serve as jurors; and

WHEREAS, service by citizens as jurors is indispensable to the judicial system; and

WHEREAS, all citizens should be encouraged to respond when summoned for jury service; and

WHEREAS, a continuing and imperative goal for courts, the bar, and the broader community is to ensure that the jury selection and jury service are fair, effective and not unduly burdensome on anyone; and

WHEREAS, one of the most significant actions a court system can take is to show appreciation for the jury system and for the thousands of citizens who annually give their time and talents to serve on juries.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED that the Comal County Commissioners Court, duly convened and acting in its capacity as the governing body of Comal County, hereby names May 1-5, 2023 as Jury Appreciation Week in Comal County.
