Proclamation

Recognizing May 2023 as Mental Health Awareness Month in Comal County

WHEREAS, throughout the nation, we recognize May as Mental Health Awareness Month, a time to promote awareness of resources available to us and our community; and

WHEREAS, the area that someone lives in plays a significant role in their overall health and well-being; and

WHEREAS, surroundings can impact if, how, and when a person's needs are met, which in turn affects mental health; and

WHEREAS, having safe, stable, and healthy home conditions set the foundation for achieving and maintaining good mental health; and

WHEREAS, the importance of overcoming mental health challenges are significant and valuable to individuals, families, and our community at large; and

WHEREAS, with early and effective interventions, those individuals with mental health conditions can recover and lead full, productive lives; and

WHEREAS, each business, school, government agency, health care provider, organization, and citizen share the burden of mental health challenges and has a responsibility to promote mental wellness and support prevention efforts; and

WHEREAS, Comal County honors our educators, health and mental health professionals, first responders, care providers, and family members, for their dedication in each of their roles which are central to mental wellness.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED that the Commissioners Court of Comal County, Texas, duly convened and acting in its capacity as the governing body of Comal County, hereby proclaims May 2023 as Mental Health Awareness Month in Comal County and calls upon the citizens, government agencies, public and private institutions, businesses and schools in our county to recommit our community to increasing awareness and understanding of mental health, the steps our citizens can take to protect their mental health, and the need for appropriate and accessible services for all people with mental health conditions.


