Recognizing October 1, 2024 as National Night Out in Comal County

WHEREAS, the citizens of Comal County play a vital role in assisting all police agencies in Comal County through joint crime, drug, and violence prevention efforts; and


WHEREAS, police-community partnerships, neighborhood safety, awareness, and cooperation are important themes of the “National Night Out” program; and


