Proclamation

Recognizing December 4, 2024 as Tree of Angels Day in Comal County

WHEREAS, our legal system protects the rights of the accused, but it must also protect the rights of crime victims; and

WHEREAS, victims of violent crimes need support, assistance, and guidance through the criminal justice system, and through the process of healing; and

WHEREAS, People Against Violent Crime (PAVC) was formed to secure the rights of crime victims, and to coordinate with victim services providers, law enforcement agencies, and criminal justice agencies to ensure adequate resources are available to all victims of crime; and

WHEREAS, the Tree of Angels is a meaningful Christmas program specifically held in memory and support of surviving victims and victims' families to help them get through the holiday season; and

WHEREAS, Comal County recognizes the important work of those who commit themselves to assist crime victims and their loved ones with traditions like the Tree of Angels, that reflect the kind and compassionate spirit of the holiday season and encourage us all to play a role in building a safer, more just community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED by the Comal County Commissioners Court that December 4, 2024 is hereby recognized as "TREE OF ANGELS DAY" in Comal County; and

BE IT FURTHER PROCLAIMED that all Comal County citizens are encouraged to support crime victims, their families, and those who work to protect us from violence.


