Recognizing Saints Peter and Paul Catholic Church

WHEREAS, the third Comal County Jail, located on the southeast corner of what was then known as the public square, was the was used from 1879 until 1931; and

WHEREAS, the third Comal County Jail was sold by the County in 1933 and torn down in 1958 with the stone and iron from the building sold and removed; and


WHEREAS, Saints Peter and Paul Catholic Church procured some of the stone from the torn down jail to use in the expansion of the sanctuary portion of their church; and

WHEREAS, after the sixth, and current Comal County Jail was completed in 2020, Saints Peter and Paul Catholic Church contacted Comal County and offered unused stones from the third Comal County Jail; and

WHEREAS, Comal County, happy to preserve a piece of Comal County history, accepted the stones and have since used them to build a stone monument between the United States and Texas flags in front of the jail at 3000 IH-35 South.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED that the Commissioners Court of Comal County, hereby recognizes Saints Peter and Paul Catholic Church Archives Committee for documenting and preserving the transactions of the old jail stones, and offers our sincere appreciation for the contribution by Saints Peter and Paul Catholic Church of the stones to be reincorporated into the new jail, where future generations will always be able to touch a piece of the past.
