Conduct 2<sup>nd</sup> test again, making notation of the changes to the program, adjustments to the equipment and other actions taken to achieve a successful 2<sup>nd</sup> test. Recount all ballots counted on the malfunctioned machine and run the 3<sup>rd</sup> test again after the completion of counting the ballots.
