

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SELMA, TEXAS ORDERING A GENERAL ELECTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING THREE COUNCIL MEMBERS

WHEREAS, a General Election shall be ordered to be held on May 3, 2025, for the purpose of electing three Council Members for Place 4, Place 5 and Place 6;

WHEREAS, The Elections Office for Guadalupe County, the Comal County Elections Department, and the Bexar County Elections Department will be participating in the Countywide Polling Place Program (CWPP) during the next Uniform Election Date of May 3, 2025, requiring joint elections agreements with all three counties.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SELMA, TEXAS, that a General Election shall be held on May 3, 2025, the next uniform election date in the City of Selma, Texas, which is not less than thirty (30) days from the date of the adoption of this Resolution for the purpose of electing three Council Members; and

RESOLVED FURTHER, the City plans to enter into a Contract for Election Services with Guadalupe County, Comal County, and Bexar County, or with the Elections Offices or Departments or Administrators of each such County in regard to the County Elections Administrators providing various services for the election, including, without limitation, procuring and distributing election supplies, procuring and paying election judges and clerks for early voting polling places and for election day, procuring early voting polling places and election day polling places, providing equipment, providing overall supervision of the election, conducting early voting (including, without limitation, establishing the dates, times, and places for early voting), and providing other related services. All election materials and proceedings shall be printed in both English and Spanish.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that each Presiding Judge shall appoint not less than two (2) nor more than four (4) clerks.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that on Election Day, May 3, 2025, the polls shall be open from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that Early Voting by personal appearance shall be conducted each weekday at locations established by the Guadalupe County Elections Office, the Comal County Elections Department, and the Bexar County Elections Department. Early Voting Clerks shall appoint not less than (2) Deputy Early Voting Clerks in accordance with the provisions of the Texas Election Code. Early voting by personal appearance will be conducted beginning on April 22, 2025 through April 29, 2025. Early voting shall be conducted from 8:00 to 5:00 p.m. on April 22, 2025 through April 25, 2025, and from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. on April 28, 2025 and on April 29, 2025, all as provided by applicable provisions of the Texas Election Code. each County. Early voting polling locations are determined by each Elections Department and are subject to change until approved by their respective County Commissioners Court.

The Early Voting Clerks for each county are as follows:

Lisa Hayes, whose mailing address is 215 S. Milam, Seguin, Texas 78155 and whose email address is lisa.hayes@co.guadalupe.tx.us, shall serve as an Early Voting Clerk for Guadalupe County.

Bobbie Koepp, Comal County Clerk, whose address is 396 N. Seguin Ave., New Braunfels, Texas 78130 shall serve as an Early Voting Clerk for Comal County. Cynthia Jaqua, whose mailing address is 396 N. Seguin, Texas 78130 and whose email address is jaquac@co.comal.tx.us, shall serve as an Early Voting Clerk for Comal County.

Jacquelyn Callanen, whose mailing address is 1103 S. Frio, Suite 100, San Antonio, Texas 78207 and whose email address is jcallanen@bexar.org shall serve as an Early Voting Clerk for Bexar County.

Permanent employees of the Guadalupe County Elections Office, the Comal County Elections Department, and/or the Bexar County Elections Department are hereby appointed as Deputy Early Voting Clerks.

The Early Voting Ballot Board shall consist of the Presiding Judge and Alternate Presiding Judge and other members, appointed by the Presiding Judge, who are eligible to serve in accordance with the Texas Election Code. Early voting ballots shall be canvassed by the Early Voting Ballot Board.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that applications for ballots by mail shall be mailed to the Early Voting Clerk of the County where the voter resides; and that applications for ballots by mail must be received no later than the close of business on April 22, 2025.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that Notice of said General Election to be held on May 3, 2025, is hereby ordered to be given: (a) by publication one time in a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Selma, not less than ten (10) nor more than thirty (30) days prior to the date set herein for such election; and (b) by posting such Notice at City Hall and in each election precinct of the City not less than twenty-one (21) days prior to the date set herein for such election.

RESOLVED FURTHER, all qualified resident electors of the City shall be permitted to vote at the election and shall vote at the designated countywide polling place in the county where they reside. The election shall be held and conducted in accordance with the provisions of the Texas Election Code, as amended, and the provisions of the Texas Local Government Code, as amended, and as may be required by any other law.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the Notice of General Election and election order shall be in force and effect from and after the date of its adoption and shall be posted according to

election law requirements.
